

#### **Instruction:**


- 1. Set up Bee Bot Mats by placing alphabet cards on the squares.
- 2. Students will program the bee bot to target letters of sight words they are trying to spell.
- 3. Students will first place bee bot on start square (placed in top right corner)
- 4. Then student will program the bee bot to the first letter of the word, hit pause button, and then program Bee Bot to second letter of the word, hit pause button, and so on. This way it is apparent which letters the student is trying to get the Bee Bot to hit rather than just rolling over them.
